


## Festive update

## Dear Parents and Carers

Although it is only November, the rest of the term is really busy, so I wanted to take this opportunity to update you with the festive plans.

You should have all received an email with specific information for your child's sing-a-long and party day. Please read this carefully and make a note of the specific times that apply to you. If you have not had this, please speak to the office so they can help.

The festivities kick off at the **Dorking Gala on Sunday 1**<sup>st</sup> **December!** As the only maintained nursery school in Dorking, we are fully part of this community event, but as always, we cannot do it without you. We will be based in the United Reform Church: -

- We will be serving refreshments all day from 11am 5pm in the URC can you spare an hour to help on the stall?
- Everyone loves a cake with a cuppa, so we are asking for cake donations on either Friday 29<sup>th</sup> December (if they are able to be kept for two days) or dropped off to the URC from 10.30am on Sunday 1<sup>st</sup>.

Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> December - 3-5s class only - Christmas Party Day - 10am - midday or 12.45pm - 2.45pm - please check your letter for the session your child is invited to. There are no normal sessions in the 3-5s nursery on this day.

Thursday  $19^{th}$  December - SEND class only - Christmas Party Day and Sing-a-long - 9.30am - 11.30am or 12.30pm - 2.30pm - please check your letter for the session your child is invited to. There are no normal sessions in the SEND nursery on this day. Parents have been invited back for a specific time, either 11am or 2pm.

Friday 20th December - Pyjama Day - 'The Night Before Christmas'

- Children (and staff!) to wear their pyjamas for the day (no onesies please).
- Last day of term.

Monday 6th January 2025 - Start of term for spring, nursery open as normal.
